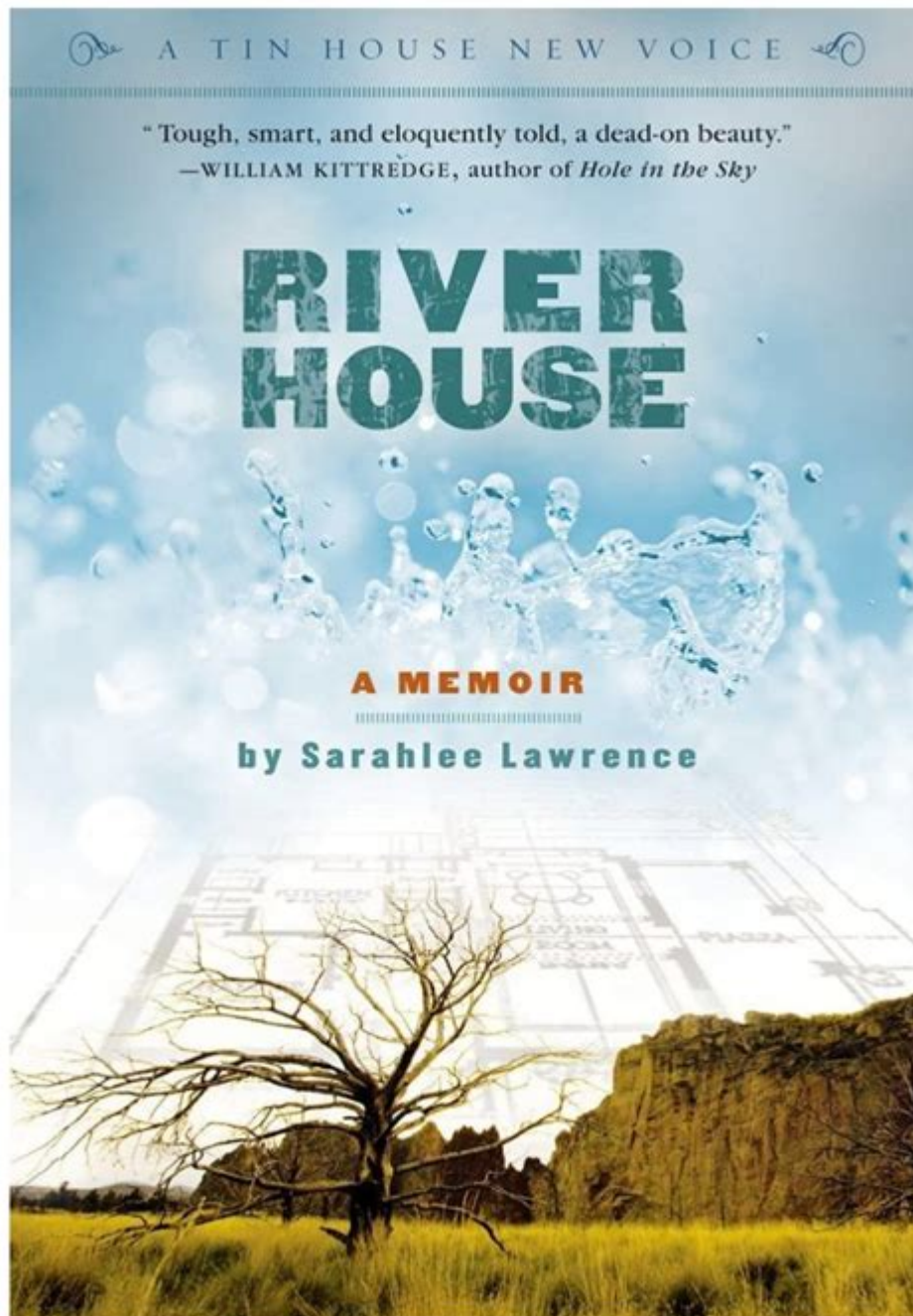
- **Back Alleys & Side Streets:** Cafes tucked away in less visible spots often cater to a slower pace, ideal for spending an hour or two engrossed in a book.
