

Good translators often pick novels that align with their own taste for quality, increasing the chances you'll enjoy them too. This is a shortcut to finding similar high-quality content.



Embrace Experimentation and Keep an Open Mind

Sometimes, the best discoveries come from stepping outside your comfort zone. Try a subgenre you've previously avoided, or read a novel with a premise that's slightly unusual. Your tastes evolve, and what you disliked yesterday might captivate you today. Don't be afraid to drop a novel if it's not working, but
