- **Goals:** To become the strongest martial artist, avenge wrongs, protect the innocent, uphold justice, or achieve personal enlightenment through martial arts.



Xianxia: Ascending to Immortality

Xianxia, meaning “immortal heroes” or “immortal cultivators,” takes the fantastical elements to a cosmic scale. Drawing heavily from Chinese mythology, Taoism, and Buddhism, Xianxia novels depict protagonists striving for immortality and godhood through a rigorous process called cultivation. This involves absorbing spiritual energy, refining the body and soul, and breaking through various cultivation realms.

- **Core Tropes:** Cultivation, spiritual beasts, demons, gods, magical artifacts, vast multi-layered realms, reincarnation, and cosmic laws. Protagonists often possess unique “spiritual roots” that determine their cultivation path and wield powerful magic and divine abilities.

- **Goals:** To achieve immortality, transcend mortality, become a god, protect their sect/loved ones, or master the dao (the fundamental laws of the universe).

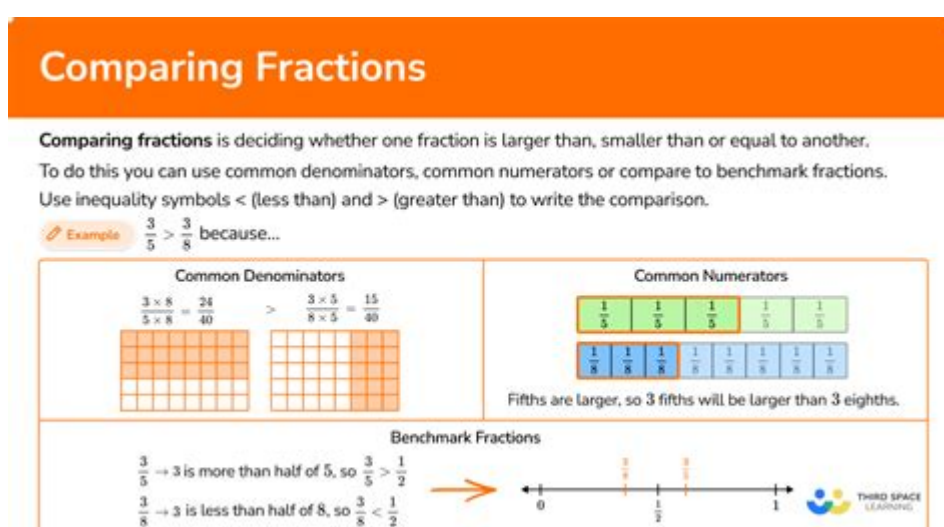

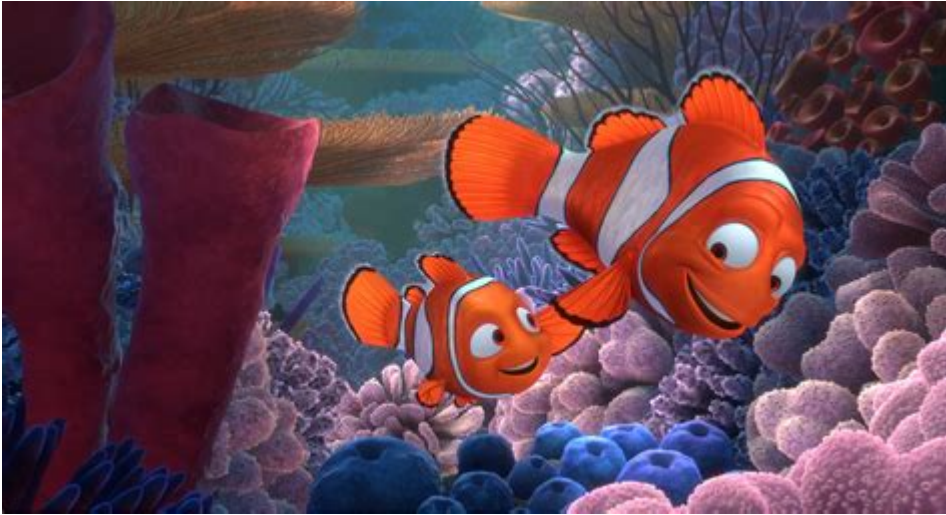
