

Liane Moriarty starts the 2nd chapter for the above with the heading, '10 Years Later'.

5. Give historical context

George R. R. Martin starts a pre- *Game of Thrones* history with how eras are named.

6. Hint at coming focus

Martin builds anticipation for a 'cruel and bloody' historical war at Chapter 2's start.

7. Share character facts

In Circe, Madeline Miller begins with key facts about the narrator's race (nymphs).

8. Build narrative suspense

Circe's 2nd chapter starts by foreshadowing an impending punishment for Circe's uncle.

9. Begin with a vivid image

Ta-Nehisi Coates starts *The Water Dancer* with the image
of a dancing, ghostly mother.

10. Share a greatest desire

Coates starts Chapter 2 by sharing his narrator's lifelong desire - to be free.

A truly great Wuxia/Xianxia novel will often subvert expectations, introducing elements that challenge the reader's preconceived notions of the genre.

Strategies for Vetting Potential Reads
