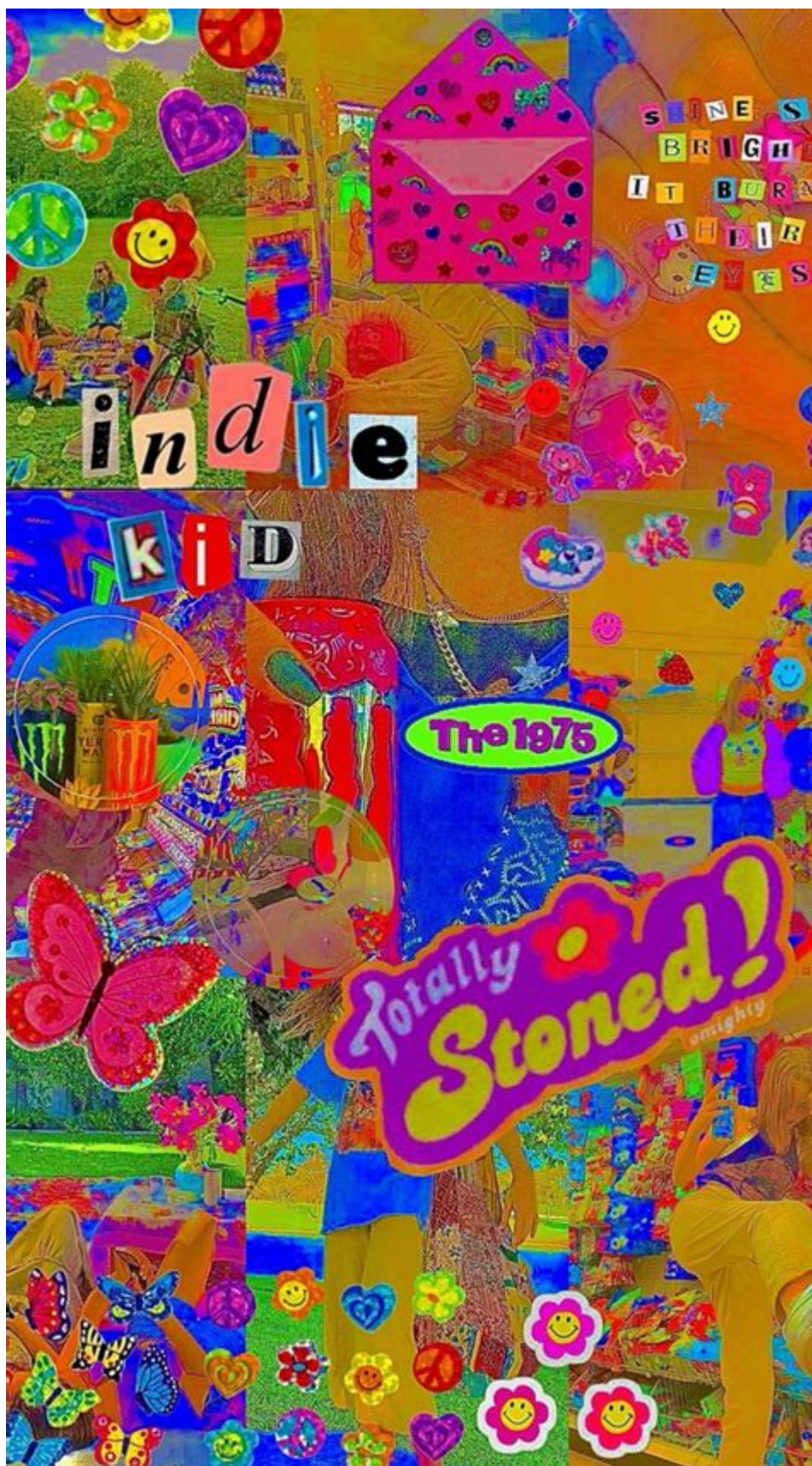


## **2. Digital Libraries and Archives**

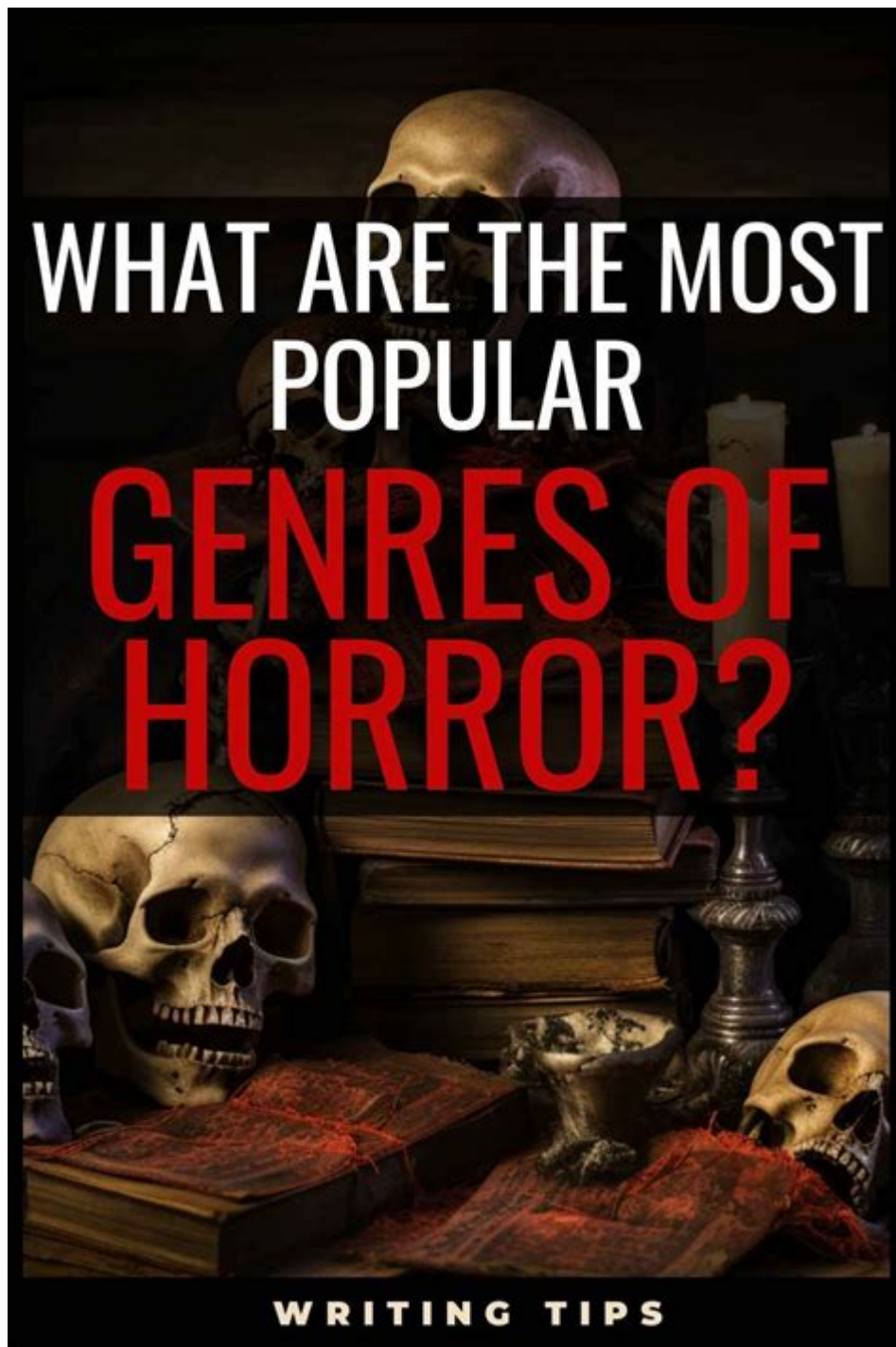


## Beyond the Supernatural: Exploring Subgenres
