

Red Flags and Green Lights: Spotting Quality



- Amateurish or Generic Cover: Can be a sign of a self-published book that lacked professional polish.
- Typos or Grammatical Errors in Blurb/Preview: If the blurb isn't proofread, the book itself likely won't be either.
- Only a Few Vague Reviews: Especially if they seem overly enthusiastic without specifics, or are from accounts with no other activity.




Strategic Sampling: Don't Commit Too Soon
