- **Grimdark:** A subgenre of dark fantasy with a more cynical, nihilistic tone.

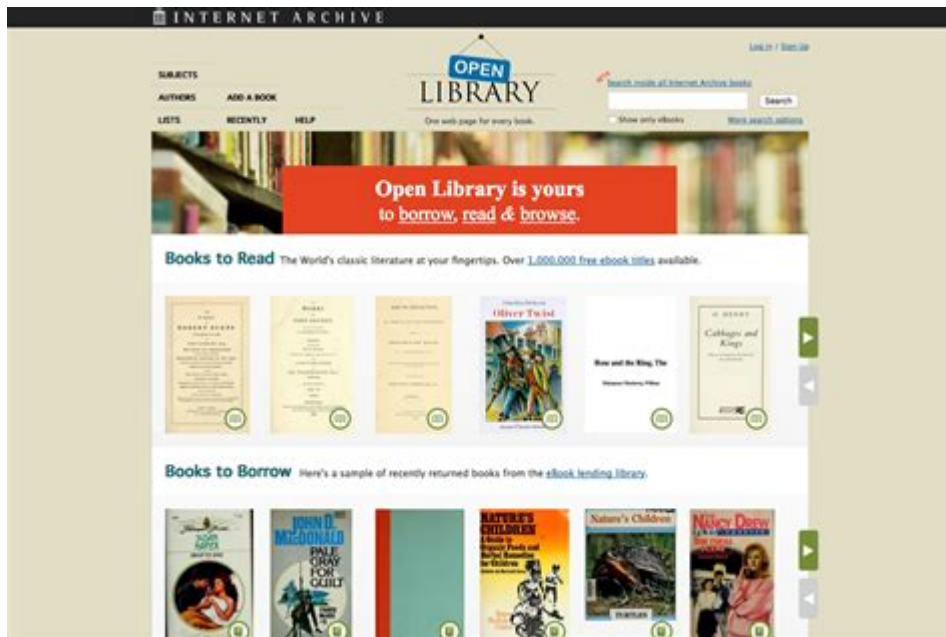
Each subgenre offers unique storytelling conventions, world-building styles, and character archetypes that can feel incredibly fresh.
