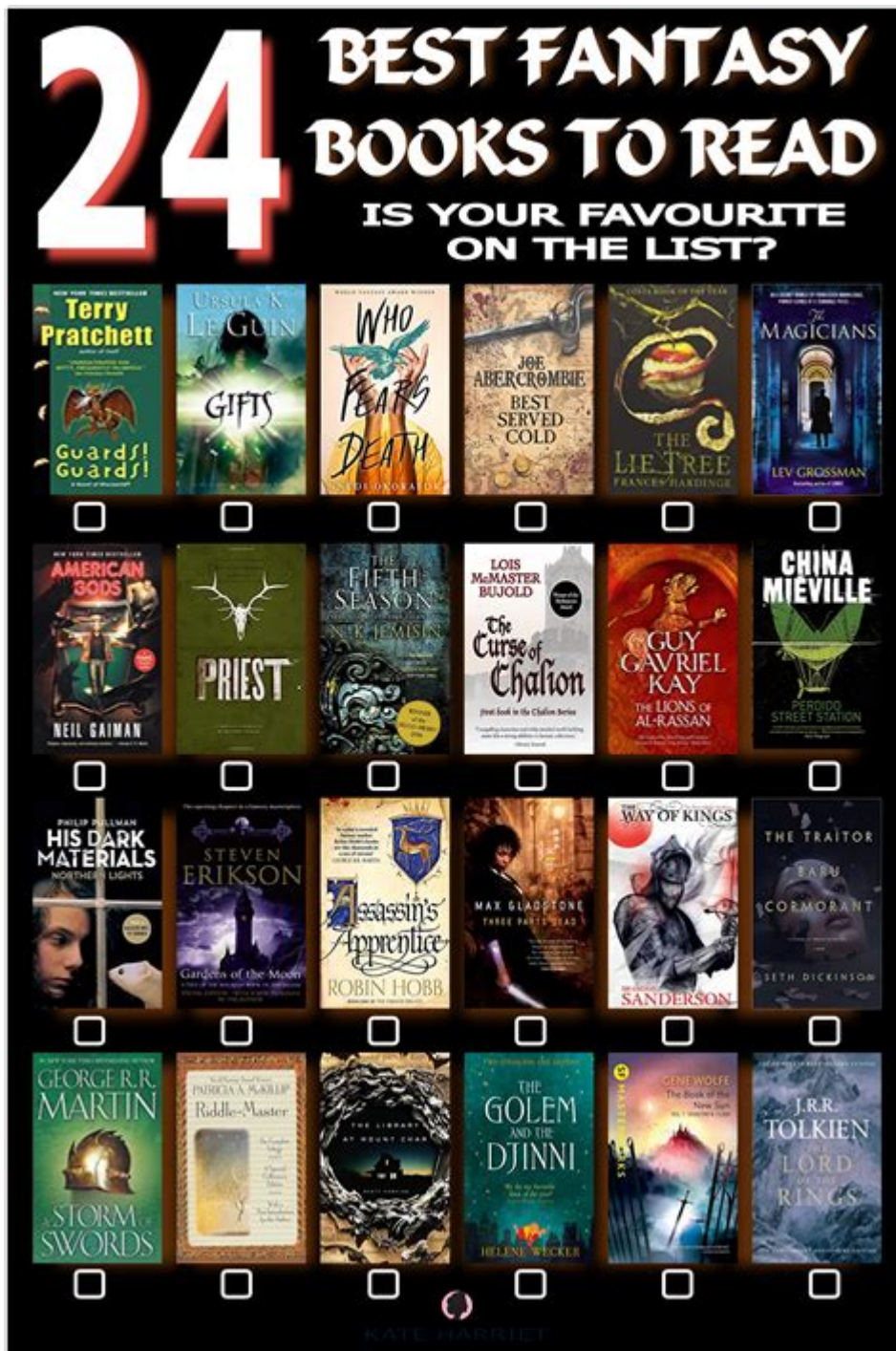

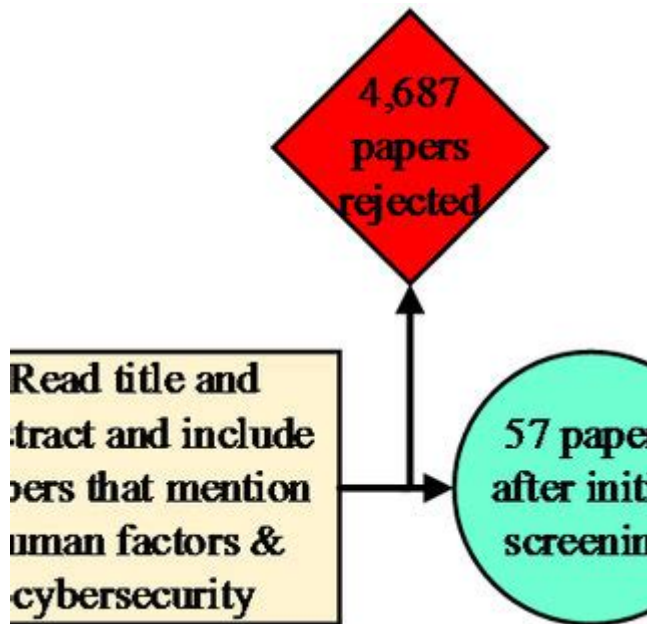


## Mastering the Art of Filtering and Discovery
