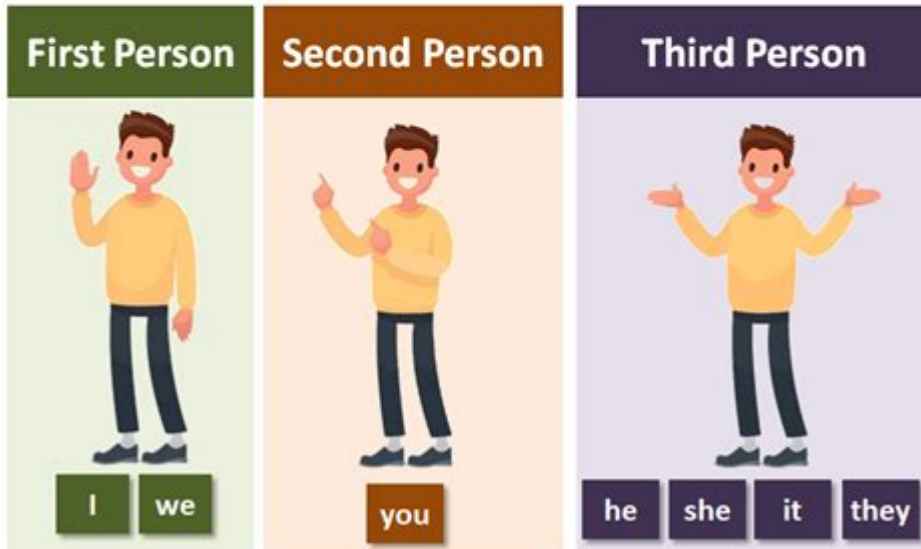
You don't need to read hundreds of chapters to gauge a novel's potential:
