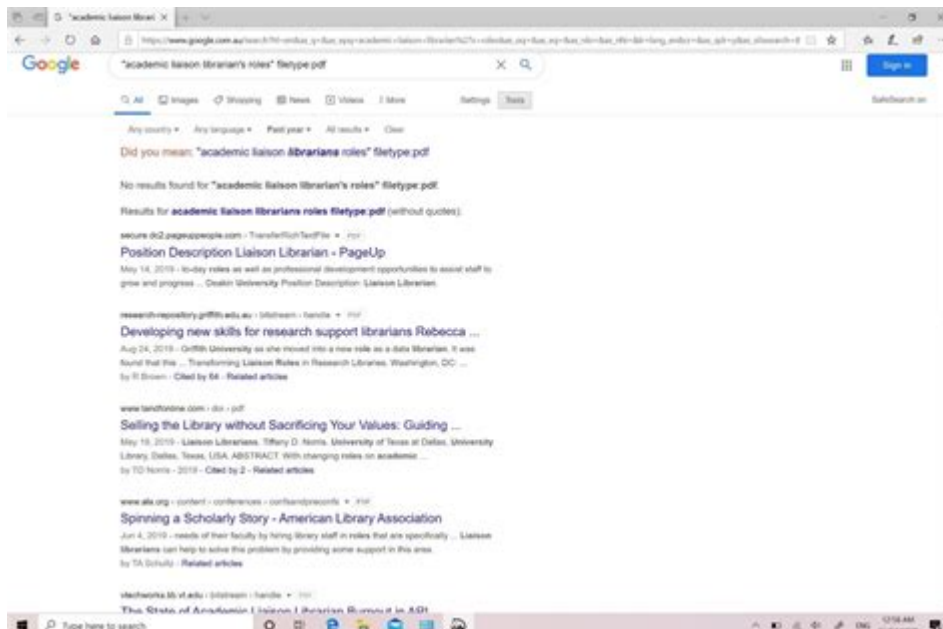
Book Promotion Sites (Freebooksy, BookBub, EreaderIQ)

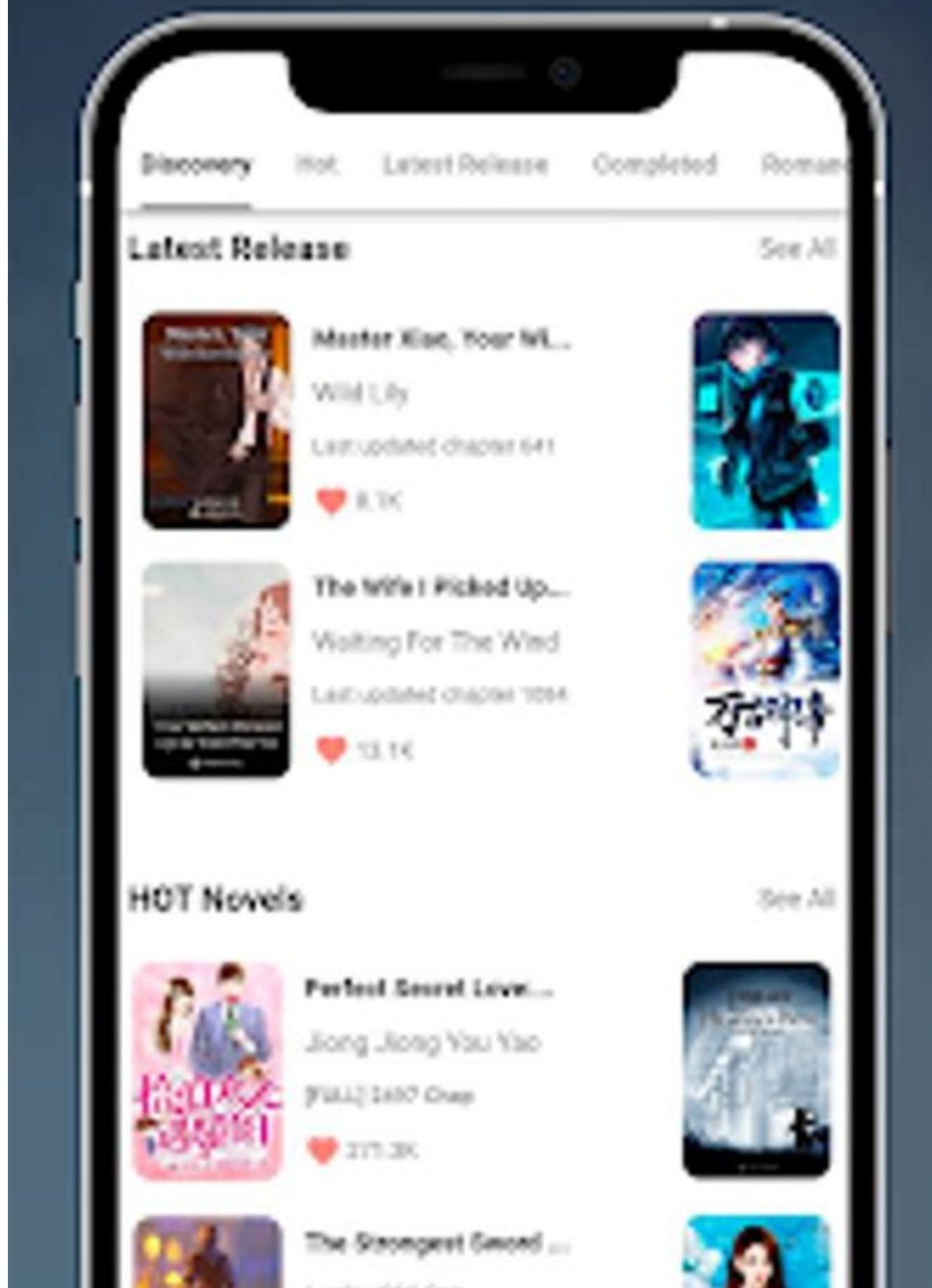
- **Generic or Low-Quality Covers:** While not always indicative of bad writing, a poorly designed cover can sometimes suggest a lack of professional polish.
