Awards like the RITA Awards (historically), the Audie Awards for audiobooks, or indie-focused awards often highlight critically acclaimed novels that stand out for their innovation, storytelling, and unique approaches to romance. Even if a winner seems outside your usual scope, giving it a try can be a rewarding experiment.



Rethink Your Author-Centric Habits

Many readers find comfort in sticking with favorite authors. While there's nothing wrong with enjoying beloved writers, it can inadvertently limit your exposure to new ideas. Make a conscious effort to pick up debut novels or books by authors you've never read before. Look for authors from different backgrounds, cultures, and geographical locations, as their unique perspectives will naturally lead to different kinds of stories and romantic dynamics.

Consider reading an author's earlier works if you only know their recent bestsellers, or explore their pen names if they write in multiple genres. Sometimes, an author's hidden gems lie in their less-known backlist or experimental projects.
