Many websites are specifically designed for discovering and sharing free reads.

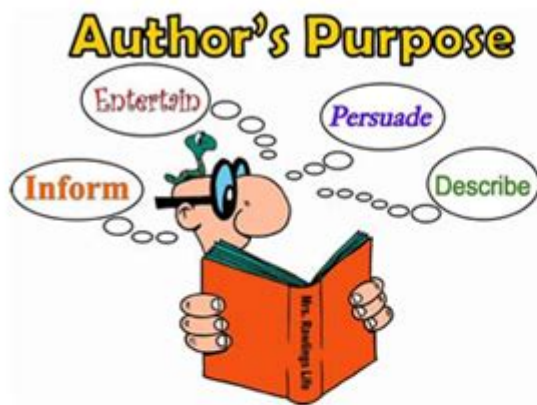
