If you're not hooked or notice significant issues within this short timeframe, move on. Your time is precious.

Follow Your Favorite Authors and Trends

If you've enjoyed a particular author's work, chances are you'll enjoy their other creations or what they recommend. Many indie authors actively promote each other, forming a network of related content. Keep an eye on authors you love for mentions of other free books or authors they admire. Similarly, staying aware of current fantasy trends can help you discover new subgenres or styles that might appeal to you.
