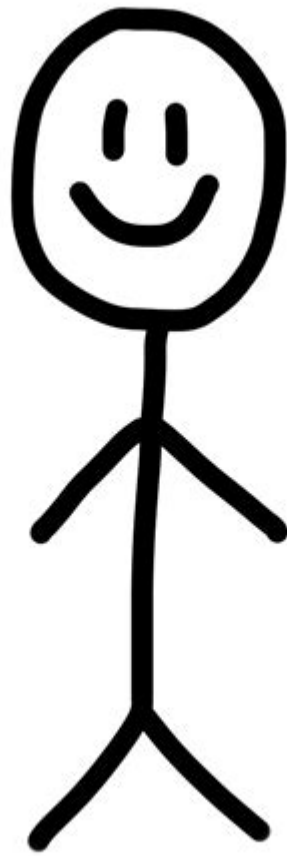
## Beyond the Big Names: Digging Deeper
