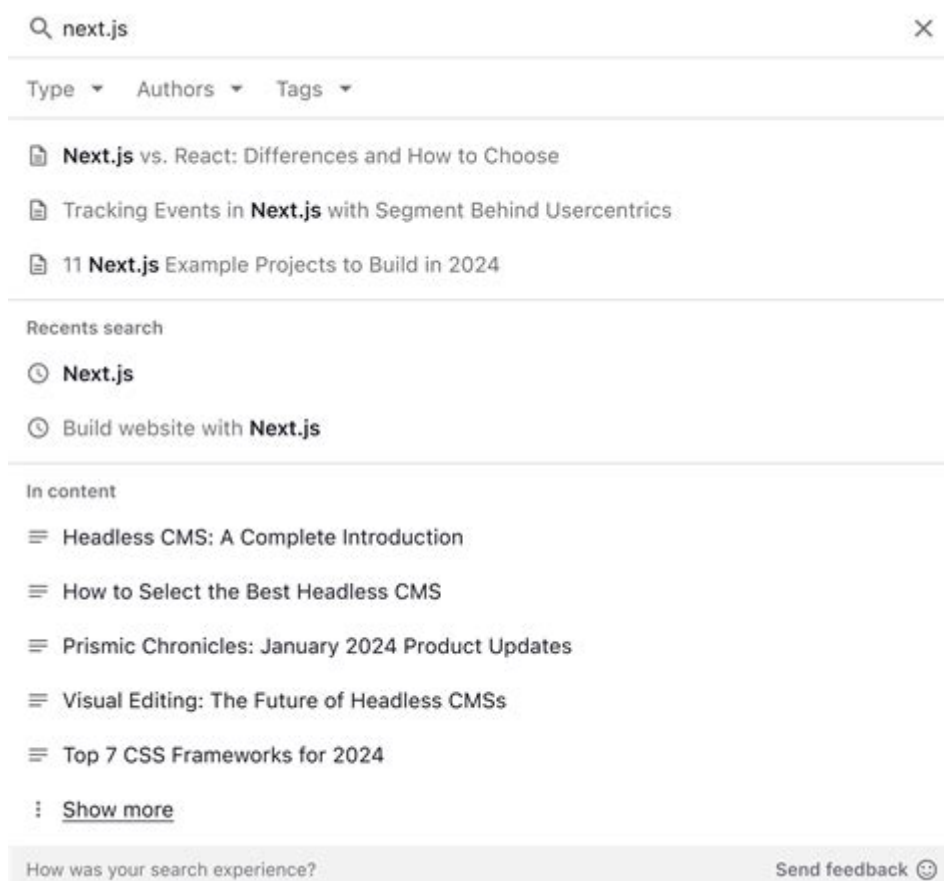
Leveraging Curated Platforms and Digital Libraries

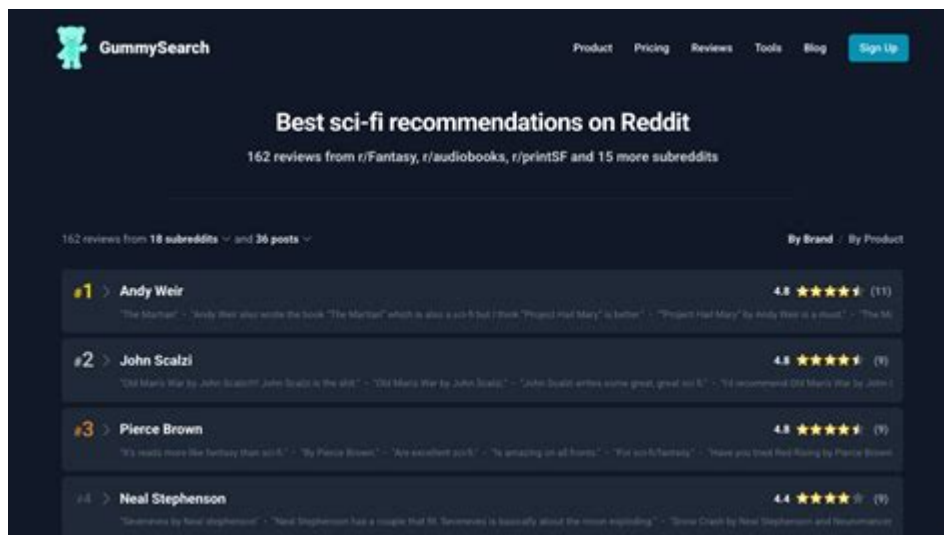
Mastering the Art of Search and Filters
