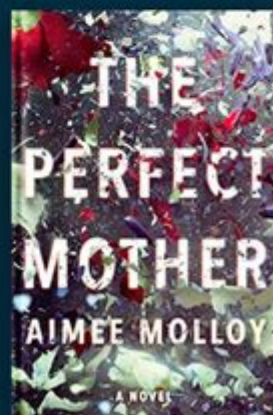
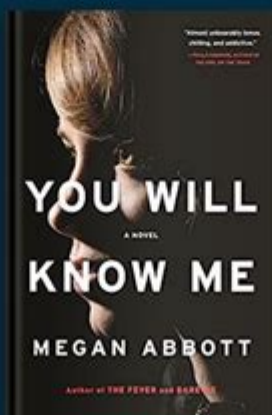
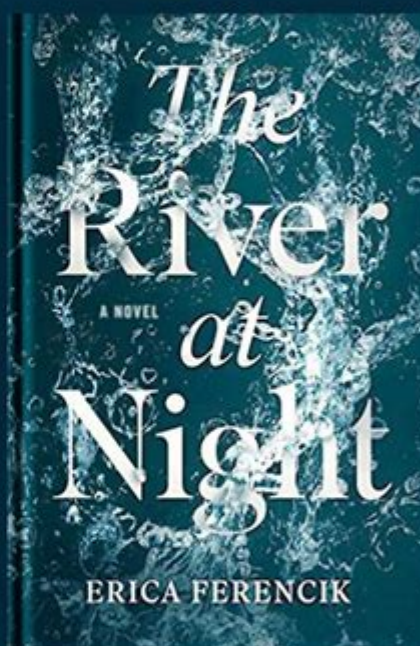
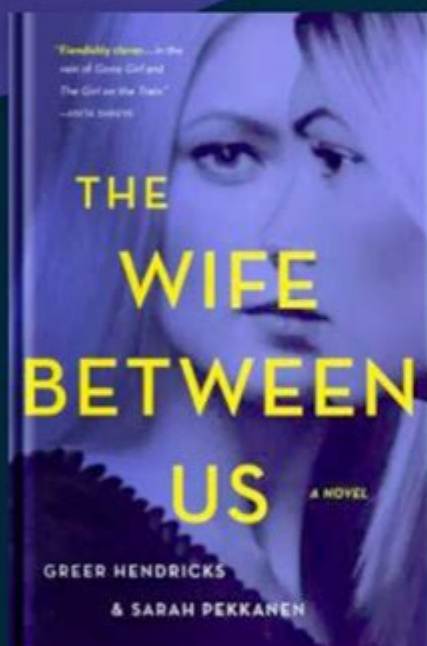
To identify genuine suspense, you first need to recognize the hallmarks of predictability:
