Personal story hooks might be longer than 1 sentence. They are useful because personal stories can personalise an essay immediately. However, they depend on having a story relevant to the topic

Make sure they do not become long and irrelevant. Remember that hooks should be catchy...do not ramble!

Spotting Fresh Action and Character Depth


Fresh action isn't just about the 'what,' but the 'how' and 'why.'

- **Beyond the Punch:** Does the action serve the plot and character development, or is it merely filler? Look for scenes where characters make difficult choices under pressure, where the environment plays a crucial role, or where the stakes feel genuinely high. Innovative magic systems, unique technological gadgets, or clever tactical decisions can elevate simple combat into memorable action.
- Character-Driven Conflict: Even the most spectacular action sequence falls flat without characters you care about. Seek stories where protagonists evolve through their adventures, face internal conflicts as much as external ones, and where their decisions drive the narrative forward. A strong plot often stems from a strong character arc.
